Review of protected animals management framework

New online reporting requirements

Online record keeping will replace the current hardcopy movement advice requirements. Licence holders will only be required to use the online system once they move to a Standard, Specialised or Advanced licence.

The online system will provide real time data and improve the department's ability to monitor and enforce licensing requirements.

If accessing or using the online system poses unnecessary hardship, licence holders will be able to apply to the department for an exemption to continue keeping their records in hard copy books.

Under the new licencing framework you will need to notify the department within 72 hours of a trade event (such as buy/sell/giveaway/accept) or other events such as birth, death or movement of a licenced animal. Notification will be required within 24 hours of excess dangerous snakes or an excess breeding occurrence.
