### New animal licence options

The distinction between commercial purposes and recreational purposes has been removed and licences will be based on the number of animals you have and your intention to keep, breed or trade them.

<b>Animal class allowances</b>	Up to 10 individual Class 1 animals  No Class 2 animals permitted	Up to 50 Class 1 and 2 amphibians, birds, and reptiles at any given time.  Unlimited protected scorpions and spiders	Unlimited Class 1 and 2 animals  Exception: maximum of 50 permitted dangerous snakes
<b>Breeding</b>	No breeding permitted	Breeding permitted within animal limit	Breeding permitted
<b>Trading</b>	Restricted within six (6) months of acquisition	Restricted within six (6) months of acquisition	No restrictions
<b>Online record keeping and movement advice</b>	Yes	Yes	Yes

## Overview of proposed new licence allowances

### Standard licence:

- Cost for five (5) years is \$59.20
- Up to 10 Class 1 animals
- Class 2 animals not permitted
- Breeding is not permitted
- Trading is restricted within six (6) months of acquisition
- Online record keeping (replaces hardcopy movement advice)
- Dangerous snakes not permitted

### Specialised licence:

- Cost for five (5) years is \$316.90
- Up to 50 Class 1 and 2 amphibians, birds, and reptiles permitted at any given time and unlimited protected scorpions and spiders.
- Breeding permitted within animal limit
- Trading restricted within six (6) months of acquisition
- Online record keeping (replaces hardcopy movement advice)
- New dangerous snake conditions apply

### Advanced licence:

- Cost for five (5) years is \$682.90

- Unlimited Class 1 animals
- Unlimited Class 2 animals with an exception of maximum of 50 permitted dangerous snakes
- Breeding permitted
- No restrictions on trading
- Online record keeping (replaces hardcopy movement advice)
- New dangerous snake conditions apply
